A runner-up will be selected to receive the scholarship if the winner does not matriculate at an accredited college during the 2024-2025 academic year.

Instructions for Completing Application

- The completed application including the essay must be sent to the following email address: <u>DBLinks.Scholarship@gmail.com</u> by April 5, 2024.
- Late applications will not be accepted. Winners will be notified by April 29, 2024.
- Applicants will be judged on scholarship, extra-curricular activities, civic/community service, leadership, resourcefulness, and essay (technique, originality and creativity). The applicant must have a minimum **3.0 GPA**, which must be verified by a copy of a current transcript submitted with the application.
- In addition to the information requested in the application, applicants must submit **two letters of recommendation** from responsible persons, other than relatives, who are well acquainted with them.
- The application must be **typed or neatly handwritten** in ink and must be **signed** by the applicant. Additional sheets of white paper may be used if necessary.
- **Pages should be numbered**. The application's face page is the first page. Please be sure to place the question topic next to information on additional sheets.

Your application, with the attached requirements, will be evaluated by The Daytona Beach (FL) Chapter of The Links, Incorporated's Scholarship Committee.

- Put the topic at the head of the paper.
- Please sign the essay.
- Your essay will be assessed on writing technique/style, originality and creativity. Therefore, be aware of your grammar and spelling.

Essay Topic: Write an original minimum **300-word** essay on <u>one</u> of the following topics:

Topic 1: Recount a time when you faced a challenge, setback, or failure. How did it affect you, and what did you learn from the experience?

Topic 2: What do you consider to be the single most important societal problem as a person of color? Why?
