Dear Scholarship Applicant:

The Peabody Auditorium Foundation Scholarship is designed specifically to encourage the pursuit of higher education goals among Volusia County graduating high school seniors who are pursuing a degree/career in the performing arts (i.e., dance, music, or theater). It is intended that the award, in the amount of \$1,000.00, be used to support the recipients with college expenses.

Qualifying Criteria: The criteria to qualify for this scholarship requires that the applicant be a graduating senior, has a minimum grade point average of 3.0, a clear and concise essay explaining post high school plans and career aspirations in the performing arts, proposed major (must be in the performing arts) and minor, and letters of recommendation from educators or employers.

All applications must include the following:

1. Complete application with all documents and items of support.
2. Biographical essay **MUST** include career aspirations in the performing arts (100 words/full page minimum typed).
3. Two letters of recommendation from educators or employers.

The completed application MUST be postmarked no later than Friday, March 29, 2024.
